


Foley Editing Assignment



In this lesson you will be given a film clip to import to iMovie, and create a brand new soundtrack. You will be using your own narration, Foley effects, score, etc. Follow the directions carefully, so you do not skip any steps.

Step 1 - Import the Film Clip to iMovie

Open iMovie, Go to FILE > NEW MOVIE > NO THEME
Click on the Import Arrow and then Navigate to the Desktop and your folder to import the movie. Drag the clip of the movie into your timeline.

Step 2 - Create a Cue Sheet - See additional Work Sheet

For every sound needed you will need to record it on the sheet. You may use pre-recorded sounds, but you will get more credit if you make the sounds yourself, remember this is a Foley assignment. If there is talking, you will create a new narration track. If there are sound effects, you will recreate those and add your own score. Make a list below of all the sounds you will need. Include the time code where that sound will be inserted. Once you have all your sounds marked on the sheet, begin recording your sounds and collect them in a folder on the desktop. When you have all your sounds, import them to iMovie.

Step 3 - Creating the Sounds

Record your sounds on your phone, or on your computer. **You may also use free sounds on the internet, as long as they are cited in your credits, so keep a list of what you use and their source.**

Step 4 - Editing the Video

Begin adding sounds and match them as close as you can to timing, volume and so that the sounds have a realistic feel when you watch the movie. If you think music should be underneath some of the movie, choose your music for the score and adjust appropriately so it doesn't take away from the sound effects when necessary. This will take some time, so work for accuracy as much as possible.

Step 5 - Post Production

Add a Title, and any other titles you think necessary. Add a Credits Slide that shows who did the editing, where you got all your sources, including the video. When you are ready, I'll give you the link of the original video. All your sound sources should be listed. If you created sounds, in the credits it should reflect that.

Example: Sound Designer - Mrs. Eitner.

If you used pre-recorded sound effects, include the website and type of effect.

Step 6 - Turning in your video.

Export your video to a file, title it, FoleyMovieEdit_YourLastName , Upload through Google Classroom and turn it in. The rubric will be on the website for you to download before you turn it in for grading.
